Based on the defendant's conviction of AGGRAVATED MURDER a 1st Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than twenty five years and which may be life in the Utah State Prison.

Based on the defendant's conviction of ATTEMPTED AGGRAVATED MURDER a 1st Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than fifteen years and which may be life in the Utah State Prison.

Based on the defendant's conviction of FELONY DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM a 1st Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not less than five years and which may be life in the Utah State Prison.

Based on the defendant's conviction of FELONY DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM a 3rd Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not to exceed five years in the Utah State Prison.

Based on the defendant's conviction of FELONY DISCHARGE OF A FIREARM a 3rd Degree Felony, the defendant is sentenced to an indeterminate term of not to exceed five years in the Utah State Prison.
